

Ways to respond today. (continued)

Believers should not take communion in an unworthy manner. They should take communion in a repentant state, approaching Jesus with an open heart.

The bread represents the body of Christ that was broken for us, the grape juice represents the blood He shed for our sins on the cross. Believers will tear a piece of bread off the loaf and dip it into the cup of grape juice. Then, they take the bread and eat it, remembering what Christ has done for them.

#### ❖ Offering

During the response time we have a box located on the communion table where we encourage those who consider Integrity Church their home to give. We believe that giving is an issue of stewardship, sacrifice, and an act of worship. If you are a guest with us this morning we do not ask you to give.

#### ❖ Connect

You can use the connection card (located in your bulletin) to ask questions, list prayer requests, or tell us how we can assist you and/or your family in any way. You can place the connection card in the box on the communion table or the basket on the welcome table out in the lobby.

#### ❖ Resources

We have Bibles available on the welcome table. If you do not own a Bible, please feel free to take one home with you. Occasionally, we will have other resources provided to help you in your walk with God.

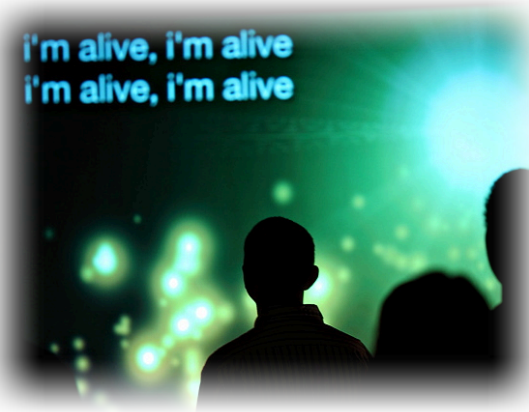

We understand that visiting a church can be an intimidating experience. We've all been the new person at church before. So, we desire to remove as much of the potential awkwardness out of your experience as we can.



# welcome to integrity church

Sit back. Make yourself comfortable.

Our Sunday service usually last about 75 minutes. It's designed to be accessible for you, whether you've spent your life in the church or have never been to a church service before. Each aspect is explained and participation is up to you.

This worship guide is designed to help you understand the various aspects of our service. We usually stand for the songs. We sit for the sermons and scripture readings. We take communion every Sunday by walking to the front tables after the sermon. If there are any changes from the usual we'll be sure to let you know.

What about children? Childcare takes place in the cafeteria which is located on the other side of this building. It is provided during the service for children ages one to four. Children ages five through ten are given the option of attending a children's teaching time mid-way through the service.. During the service, you will see an image on the screen prompting the children to be dismissed. This will take place before the sermon.

What you can expect out of this service.

Our Sunday service is designed to be a time when followers of Jesus, those who don't know Him, and the curious to gather together and learn more about Jesus and themselves. The story of Jesus is over 2000 years old. Together we will see how its ancient truth impacts us today.

If you are not a follower of Jesus we encourage you to check out the claims He has made about Himself and us. Consider the life change He promises to His followers and the life He enables them to live. If you have questions or just want to talk more about this, please let one of our leaders know.

If you are a follower of Jesus, worship God. Passionately engage Christ and His gospel. Pray that the Holy Spirit would use what happens at Integrity to make you more like Jesus.

Ways to respond today.

❖ Communion (see 1 Cor. 11:23-29)

Communion, also called The Lord's Supper, is the family meal for Christians. Integrity Church encourages all committed followers of Jesus to partake of this sacrament. If you have forsaken your sin and trusted in Jesus alone for your salvation, are a baptized member of a congregation that preaches the gospel, and seek strength to live more faithfully for Christ, we invite you to partake in Communion with us.

If you are not a Christian or are not prepared to share this meal, observe believers partaking and celebrating what Christ has done for them. We hope this time is helpful to you as you consider your relationship with Jesus, His people and the Church.

How do we do communion?

We celebrate communion as a response to God's word. After the sermon and during the singing, believers are invited to walk to the front table(s) where the bread and grape juice are located. Before actually partaking in communion believers need to pray and examine themselves to see if there is any unrepentant sin in their life. (continued on back)
